Busy, Record-Setting Summer at EUG

The Eugene Airport is on pace to set another passenger record in 2016. Due in part to the utilization of United Airlines' mainline aircraft and the Olympic Trials, EUG set an all-time monthly record in June with 93,181 arriving and departing passengers. July brought a record number of enplanements. As of July 31, the airport is up 7.65 percent year-to-date over activities through July 31, 2015.

"This averages out to a takeoff or landing happening every seven minutes," said Eugene Airport Director Tim Doll, A.A.E. "As we proceed through the busy summer months, we expect business to only continue to increase."

These new passenger records come as the terminal expansion project enters its final phase of construction. The beautiful new vertical circulation, expanded bag claim area and spacious B-Gates hold room are now open. Phase three includes the expansion and relocation of the TSA Screening Checkpoint. All the improvements are in response to multiple years of record growth at the airport.

The recently-completed Lane County Bilingual Directory of Services was produced and supported by the Migrant Education Program (MEP) of Lane ESD, City of Eugene Human Rights & Neighborhood Involvement, and the Integration Network for Immigrants of Lane County (IN). It provides families and individuals with information in Spanish and English about services available in Eugene, Springfield and Lane County.

Contents of the guide include information on topics such as: emergency services, housing, food, transportation, social services, health, civil and constitutional rights, legal services, employment, education, recreation and cultural services, and utility assistance. Indicated by each agency/program is whether or not they have staff who speak Spanish.

A limited number of printed directories have been made to support families with limited English and limited access to the internet and to organizations and service counters that may help support these families. If your organization or service counter is accessed by individuals who speak primarily

Spanish, one of these guides may be helpful for your staff. The guide can be accessed online at:

Acting Traffic Engineer Recognized for Leadership Excellence

Add another achievement to an already impressive list of accomplishments. Acting Traffic Engineer Matt Rodrigues was awarded the Public Works Manager credential from the American Public Works Association (APWA).

The APWA credentialing program provides leadership training for public works professionals. As part of the rigorous process, Rodrigues developed a project focused on emergency debris management planning. His research will help Eugene recover from a natural disaster.

APWA will recognize Rodrigues during its national conference later this month in Minnesota. Rodrigues will also be traveling to Sweden in September where he will conduct a study related to Sweden's implementation of Vision Zero, an initiative to eliminate transportation-related fatalities and serious injuries.
