How Registration Works:

Registration is open to all city and non-city residents and continues throughout the term. Registration is accepted on a first come first serve basis. By registering early, you can be assured of getting into your desired class or activity before it fills.

Five Easy Ways to Register:

OnLine: Use [RecEnroll](#) to search, register and pay for programs online.

Mail-in: Complete the Registration form below and mail to the recreation facility sponsoring the activity. Mail-in forms do not guarantee a space in class.

Phone in: Have your VISA or MasterCard number handy when registering by telephone. Call the recreation facility sponsoring the activity.

Fax in: Fax the registration form below to the recreation facility offering the activity.

Walk-In: Visit any recreation facility and drop off the form below to register in person.
