

Eugene Police Department Volunteer Position Description

Position:	Huckleberry Patrol Team
Location:	Initial efforts will be focused in midtown Eugene
Schedule:	Minimum expectation is two 3-5 hour shifts/month for a minimum of six months
Supervision:	Carrie Chouinard, Volunteers in Policing Program Coordinator
Objective:	Graffiti Abatement

Description of Duties

- Team members' duties include locating, digitally photographing, documenting, and removing and/or painting over graffiti.
- Initial efforts will be focused on graffiti in midtown (11th to 15th, Charnelton to Ferry).
- Volunteers operate in teams, wear department-issued uniforms (coveralls or vests), and ride bicycles provided by the department.

Requirements

- Ability to send and receive e-mail from home.
- Must have a schedule that is flexible enough to allow for attendance at meetings and trainings held on weekdays during business hours.
- Ability to ride a bicycle.
- Positive and supportive attitude with people of all backgrounds and abilities.
- Must be supportive of EPD, its mission, and comfortable working within a police environment.
- Commitment to comply with confidentiality requirements and police procedures.
- Willingness to ask questions and seek clarification if unsure of task.
- Ability to pass a police background check
- Minimum age: 16 years

Training and Preparation

- Required department-sponsored training includes *working with hazardous materials* and *Huckleberry Patrol bicycle training*.
