

Eugene Police Department Volunteer Position Description

Position:	Monroe Street Station
Location:	788 West 6 th Avenue
Hours of Operation:	Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m.
Commitment:	10+ hours/week for a minimum of three months
Supervision:	Lupé Thompson, Station Manager
Objective(s):	To provide information and referral about human services, help citizens connect with area resources, and assist citizens with public safety issues.

Description of Duties

- Greet the public, take messages, accurately maintain logs and records, regularly update reference/resource files and information, miscellaneous office jobs.
- Provide information and referral to citizens, both over the telephone and on a walk-in basis, and appropriately report information received from citizens.
- Work one-on-one with citizens, identify and evaluate problems, facilitate solutions by connecting with citizens with appropriate resource(s).

Qualifications

- Skills in listening and communicating, by telephone and in-person.
- Positive and supportive attitude with people of all backgrounds and abilities.
- Willingness to collaborate with the community, police, and other social service providers to find solutions to identified problems.
- Supportive of philosophy of the Monroe Street Station and comfortable working within a police environment which sometimes involves people-related emergencies and crisis conflict management.

Requirements

- Ability to pass a background check. A police record is not an automatic exclusion, it depends on the type of record and other factors.
- Commitment to comply with confidentiality requirements and Eugene Police policies governing the Station operations.
- 18 years of age, unless under the umbrella of a high school or college program.

Other

- Bilingual, English/Spanish, or at least conversational in Spanish, is a major asset—but not required.

Training and Job Preparation

- Orientation with the Volunteer Coordinator and Station Manager, and on-the-job training.
