Participants & Event Rules

4. Participants are not allowed to take pictures or make tape recordings unless a Deputy Chief grants permission in writing.
5. All participants must stay with their group at all times. If you must leave your group for any reason, please inform your Guide or Company Officer prior to leaving the group.
6. Report any injuries to the Guide or Company Officer, **immediately**.
7. Your demeanor and behavior must **BE PROFESSIONAL** at all times. There are things on this campus that can cause injury so it is imperative that participants follow all rules and regulations. Eugene Fire & EMS Department reserves the right to ask anyone to leave the campus for any reason.
