Fixing Eugene's Streets

Sylvan Street and Floral Hill Drive

2010 Pothole Repair Program



Project Location

- Sylvan St. (From Riverview St. to address 2022), except the portion that property owners paved in 2003 does not to be repaired.
- Floral Hill Dr. (From Sylvan St to the city limits at address 2420)

Project Overview

- Sylvan Street and Floral Hill Drive were selected for a process called full-depth reclamation (FDR) and then paved. This full depth reclamation process recycles the existing road base and pavement, mixes this material in-place with cement to add strength and then a thin asphalt pavement is applied to the surface.
- This work is similar to last year's work on Riverview and Floral Hill.



Construction Schedule

- This project is scheduled to occur in September 2010. It is anticipated the project will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.

Traffic Impacts

- These streets will be periodically closed during the reclamation and paving work. These closures should not last more than one or two days and residents within the work zone will be allowed to use the road with delays during the actual work.



Project Funding

- The Eugene City Council approved spending \$1.35 million in the current fiscal year for increased pothole repairs. Sylvan Street and Floral Hill Drive were selected to receive repairs as part of this program.
