Crisis Negotiation Team Facilitates Arrest of Burglary Suspect

Eugene Police received a call of a burglary at a residence on North Danebo Avenues at 1:45 p.m. The witness identified the suspect and through the course of the investigation officers located Michael Glenn Bailey, 28-year-old, Eugene resident, at his home in the 2500 Block of York Avenue.

Police received information that Bailey may have access to a weapon and was non-compliant with officers' request to exit the residence. At one point Bailey attempted to flee out the rear of the home where he encountered officers and quickly ran back inside; as a result the Eugene Police SWAT and Crisis Negotiation Team were activated to respond. Negotiators were able to peacefully resolve the situation and Bailey left the residence at 4:33 p.m. without further incident.

Officers are investigating the possible connection to a stolen vehicle located nearby, and charges are pending further investigation.

Thru traffic was disrupted on York Street from the 3200 block to the 2400 block from approximately 2:45 p.m. and traffic is expected to return to normal shortly as officers clear the area.
