6.5.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE

6.5.2 RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROCEDURES FOR ALL PERSONNEL

A. Generally

1. Immediately report any traffic control device that is damaged, missing, or malfunctioning.
2. You will remain at the scene and provide traffic control for:
 - missing stop signs
 - missing or non-functional traffic control signals for one lane or more, unless a duplicate signal is present and properly functioning
 - any other significant traffic hazard
3. If a traffic control signal has automatically gone into the "flash" mode, signal maintenance should be immediately notified. However, if the flashing signal is adequately controlling traffic, there is no need to remain and direct traffic.
4. Do not place traffic signals on "flash" or turn them off unless you are going to direct traffic at the intersection and need to do so to facilitate that task (refer also *Procedure 6.6 – Traffic Control and Direction*)
5. Notify dispatch of other hazardous conditions, and take reasonable steps to mitigate the hazard.
