### 4.19.2 RESPONSIBILITIES AND PROCEDURES FOR ALL PERSONNEL

#### A. Investigative responsibility

1. The Property Crimes Unit is responsible for investigation of:

- Burglary
- Theft (except theft by deception)
- Auto theft / UUV
- Criminal mischief
- selling stolen property
- weapons offenses (e.g. theft of weapons, felon in possession)
- oversight of, and coordinating investigation of, secondhand dealer transactions (including firearms transactions)
- Theft T

#### B. Notification criteria

1. The supervisor of the Property Crimes Unit should be notified any time suspects are in custody for:

- Burglary I or II
- Aggravated Theft I
- selling stolen property, car clouts, auto theft, or UUV when immediate investigative follow-up would likely lead to multiple case clearance or

recovered stolen property.
