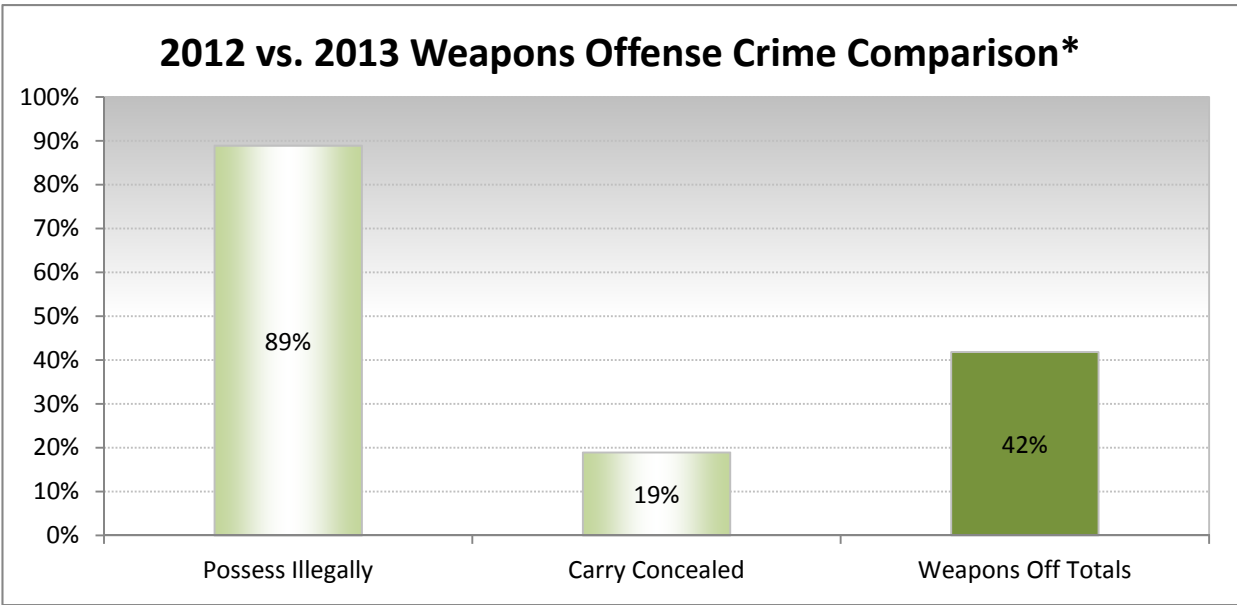

**Detail and Example:**

Over the first 3 months of 2013, officers have encountered considerably more individuals with weapons. Overall, there has been a 33% increase in Weapons Offense. There has been an 89% increase in weapons possessed illegally and a 19% increase in weapons being carried concealed. Last Friday (4/19), an officer stopped a prolific property crime offender for a bicycle light violation at the corner of Archie and Hawthorne. As the two concluded the stop, the offender began to pedal away and a shoulder holster containing a Beretta M9 pistol and three magazines tumbled onto the ground. The offender picked it up and was drawn down on by the officer. The officer's called for code 3 cover and the offender was safely detained.
