



# Project Information Sheet

## 19th Avenue, 22nd Avenue, Fillmore Street and Friendly Street Paving Project

**Project Overview:** This project involves repaving five street sections in the Friendly Area Neighbors neighborhood as follows:

- 19th Avenue & 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue between Chambers Street and Fillmore Street.
- Fillmore Street from 19th Avenue to 24th Avenue.
- 22nd Avenue from Polk Street to Friendly Street.
- Friendly Street from 24th Avenue to 28th Avenue.

Work will also include reconstructing sidewalk access ramps throughout the project in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

### **Construction Schedule (updated October 9, 2015):**

- The City has contracted with Wildish Construction to perform the Work. Work hours are typically Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 7:00pm.
- The construction work is generally complete. There may be minor clean-up and repair work happening over the next two weeks.

### **Traffic Impacts:**

- With any construction, drivers and cyclists should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.
- During the final clean-up activities, there may be short parking or lane closures.

### **Project Funding:**

- This project is primarily funded by the street repair bond passed by voters in 2012 and the local gas tax which funds the City's Pavement Preservation Program.
