

**Application Filing (See EC 9.7010)**

Applications shall be submitted on a form approved by the city manager, be accompanied by a fee established pursuant to EC Chapter 2, and be signed by the property owner, unless the applicant is a public agency, in which case the signature of the property owner is not required. Application materials shall address each of the criteria and standards applicable to the proposed use including any requested adjustments to standards as provided in provisions beginning at EC 9.8015.

**General Overview of Type I Application Procedures (See EC 9.7100)**

The Type I process provides for an administrative review of an application by the Planning Director based on provisions in the Eugene Land Use Code. The Type I application process does not include public notice.

**Type I Application Requirements and Criteria Reference (See EC 9.7105)**

The following applications are reviewed under the Type I process according to the requirements and criteria set forth for each application, as reflected in the beginning reference column in the table below.
