Jefferson Street Pavement Preservation Project

Paving of Jefferson Street from W 19th Avenue to W 24th Avenue & 25th Avenue to 28th Avenue

Project Location

Jefferson Street from 19th Avenue to 24th Avenue and from 25th Avenue to 28th Avenue

Project Overview

- Most of the work between 19th and 24th has been completed. Striping will be completed in June
- Between 25th and 28th the existing pavement will be completely removed and the base rock will be recycled in-place with cement and then repaved.
- Sidewalk access ramps have been reconstructed at several locations.



Construction Schedule

- This work started in May, 2012 and is substantially complete.

Traffic Impacts

- Minor delays are expected on Jefferson between 19th & 24th while striping is placed.
- Between 25th and 28th, the street will be completely closed for 5 days.
- Watch for construction signs and equipment.

 - Stormwater & wastewater Utility Fees
