Project Location

- MLK Jr. Boulevard from I-5 to Centennial Loop (west)

Project Overview

- This project will rehabilitate the pavement on MLK Jr. Boulevard by replacing the top layers of deteriorated pavement and removing sections of pavement that have completely failed.
- \$100k of Federal funding for this project will be used for pedestrian and bicycle improvements.
- Sidewalk access ramps will be reconstructed at several locations.
