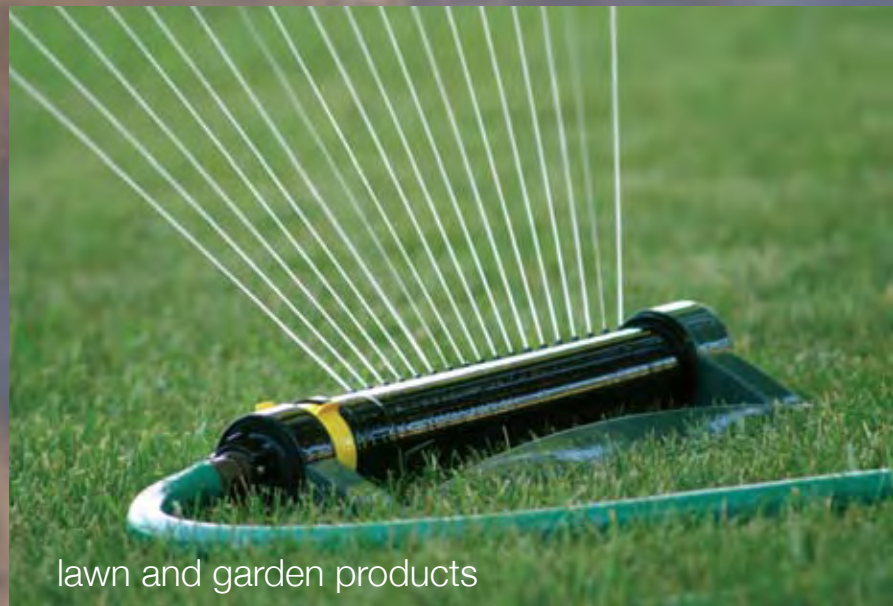
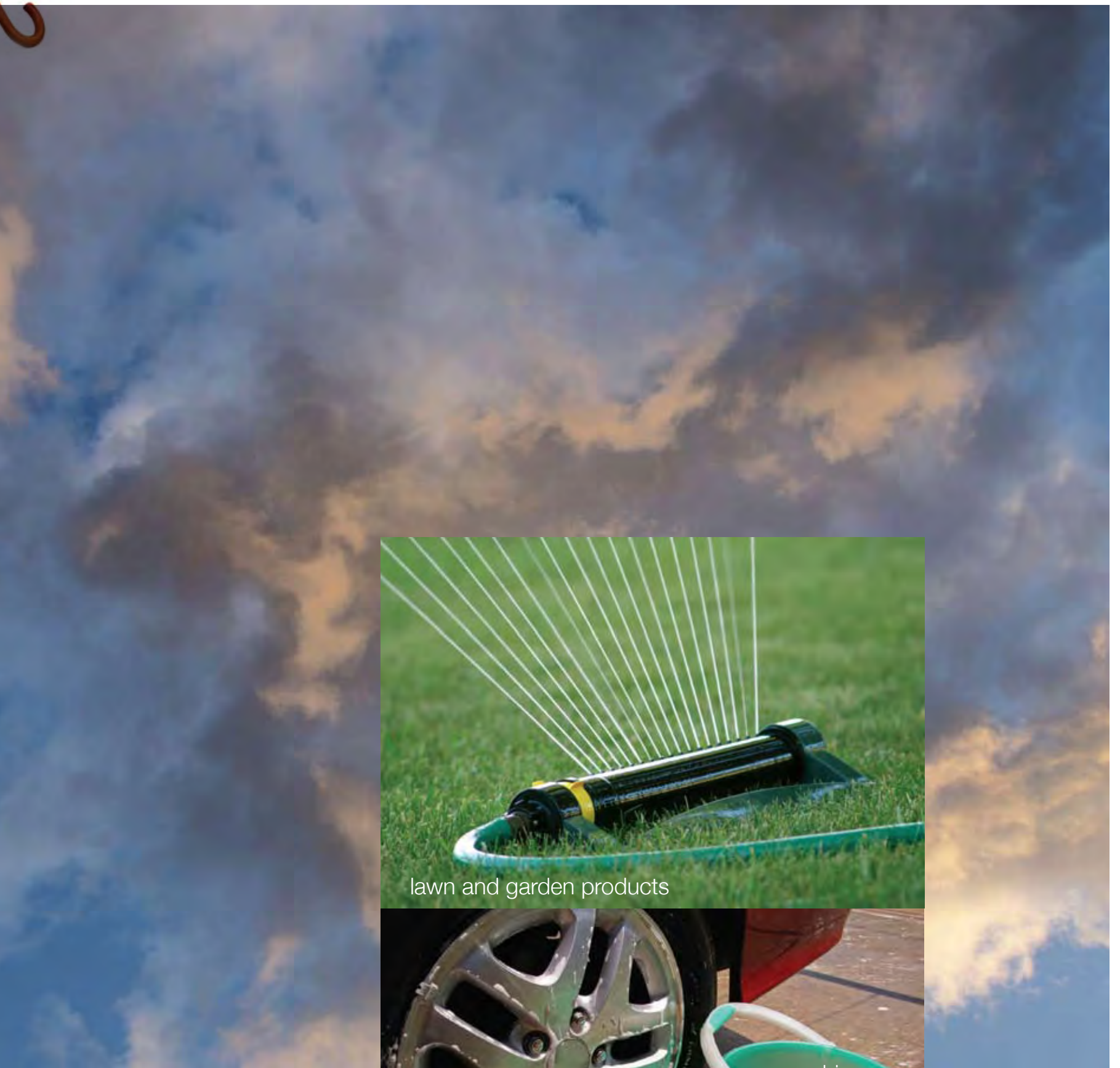




# STORMWATER

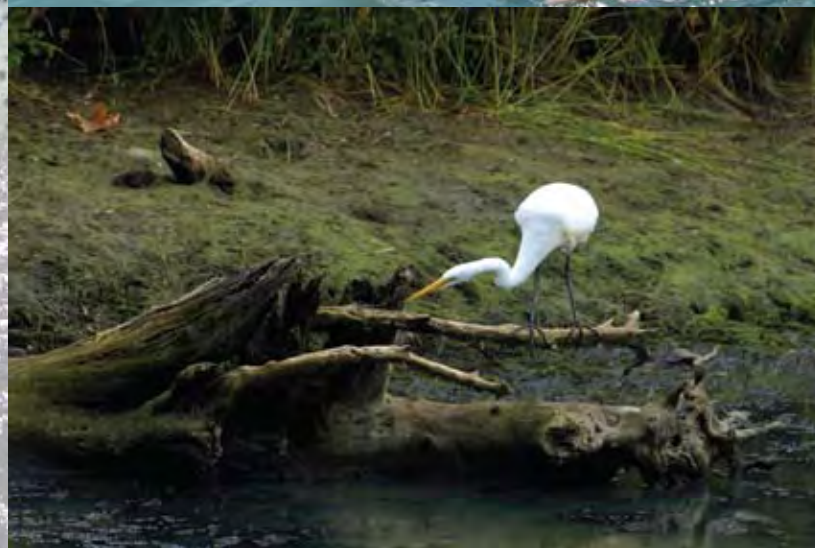
