

DISTRACTED DRIVING AVOIDANCE COURSE INFO SHEET

Beginning January 1, 2018, courts will have the ability to suspend the fine on certain Distracted Driving charges cited under ORS 811.507.

- The Distracted Driving Avoidance Course is ONLY available to 1st time offenders of the Distracted Driving/Cell Phone law ORS 811.507.
- Requests to attend the Distracted Driving Avoidance Course must be made in person at Eugene Municipal Court, located at 1102 Lincoln St, Eugene OR 97401 during normal business hours 8:00AM to 4:00PM Monday through Friday, except legal holidays and court closure days.
- The Distracted Driving Avoidance Course ONLY suspends the fine. You will still be convicted of the charge and the conviction goes on your driving record.
- The Distracted Driving Avoidance Course is offered by UTURN180 and has to be taken in person in a classroom setting.
- The Distracted Driving Avoidance Course is currently offered **every other month**, is 2 hours long, and costs \$39.95.
- You will have 4 months from your conviction date to complete the course.
- You cannot have any new citations or convictions during the 4 month period.
- Failure to complete within the 4 months will result in the enhanced fine amount due immediately.
