



HENDRICKS PARK

General Information

The picnic shelter at Hendricks Park, including the Moon Terrace deck, is available to rent year-round, excluding Sundays in April and May due to park tours. Shelter hours are from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. The street address for the F.M. Wilkins Shelter is 2200 Summit Ave., Eugene, Oregon.

Park Amenities

The picnic shelter has running water, electricity, lights, and a fireplace. Please note that water is only available from April through October. To access the fireplace, pick up a key at 1820 Roosevelt Blvd., Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. just prior to the event. It is the renter's responsibility to return the key on the first business day following the event. If the key is not returned, part or all of the deposit may be withheld.

No fires, including barbecues, are allowed inside the shelter, except inside the fireplace. Gas barbecues are allowed outside the shelter, but no charcoal or other solid fuels may be used.

No structures, including canopies or chairs, may be set up in the lawn around the shelter.

No signs may be affixed inside or outside the shelter or along the roadside.

Water is only available from April through October.

The rental of the shelter does not include use of the rhododendron garden, and no group activities of any kind are allowed in the garden.

All City of Eugene park rules apply.

Restrictions

The shelter has a 60-person maximum capacity. Because parking is very limited at the shelter and in the park, car-pooling is encouraged. Rentals are limited to 20 vehicles.

No amplified sound is allowed. Soft or low-volume music may be played with permission.

No hard liquor or glass containers are allowed.
