



Owen Rose Garden

General Information

The gazebo, the grassy area near the Cherry tree and the picnic arbor within Owen Rose Garden are available to rent for small weddings and other family gatherings. The maximum group size varies depending on the area being rented. The gazebo will hold 100 people, while the picnic arbor and the area near the Cherry tree will hold 50 people maximum. Each of the areas may be rented for a three-hour block of time, while the remainder of the garden remains open for public use. Typically, one hour of the rental time is used for set-up, one hour for the ceremony, and one hour for clean-up.

The covered gazebo is 28 feet in diameter and features a lovely rose inlay and paved walkway leading up, making it an ideal location for your ceremony. Electricity is available at this site, accessible with a key. The picnic arbor offers year-round shade and features three picnic tables for your next gathering, though there is no electricity or water available at this site. The historic Black Tartarian Cherry tree is a majestic backdrop for your special event and has played host to hundreds of weddings over the years. Owen Rose Garden also features a live web-cam that may allow you to share your moment with out-of-town friends and family.

The street address for Owen Rose Garden is 300 North Jefferson Street, Eugene, Oregon. Park hours are 6 a.m. to 11 p.m.

Park Amenities

Electricity is available at the gazebo with a key.

Fifty dark green chairs are available for rent. There is also a cart to transport the chairs. The event planner is responsible for set up and take down of the chairs. Chairs cannot be placed in any locations other than on turf and hard surface areas. The chairs are located in a shed on the east side of the fenced storage area in the garden. The key for unlocking and locking the gate of the storage area and the shed may be picked up at 1820 Roosevelt Blvd., Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. prior to the event. A separate key unlocks the electrical outlet boxes in the gazebo. It is the renter's responsibility to return the keys on the first business day after the event. If the

keys are not returned, part or all of the deposit may be held.

Restrictions


The park is available for ceremonies only; there are no facilities available for receptions.

Amplified sound is prohibited, although permission may be granted for soft or low-volume music.

Event planners must obtain permission before using chairs other than those provided at the garden. Only chairs with sled-based legs may be used on turf areas.

No hard liquor or glass containers are allowed in any City of Eugene park.

All City of Eugene park rules apply.
