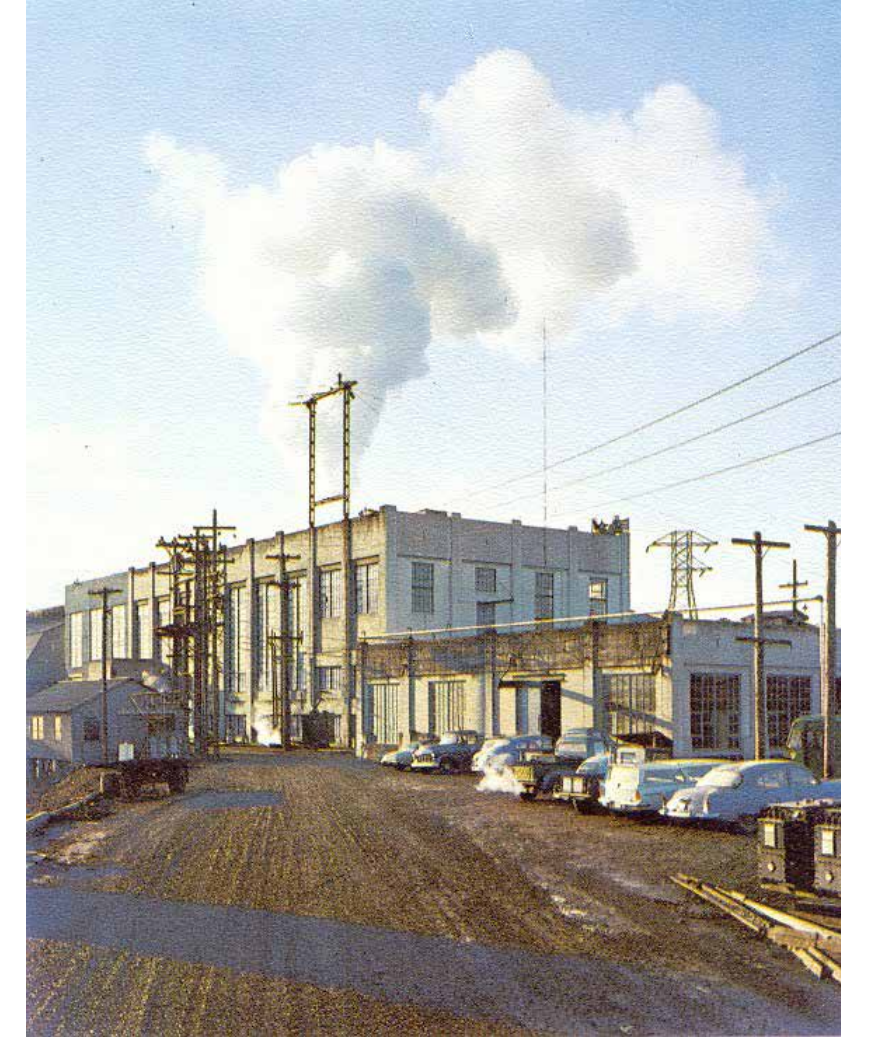


Steam Plant Re-use

Constructed in 1931, the Steam Plant powered the pumps bringing water into the City and supplied heating to downtown businesses.

The oldest standing structure on the Downtown Riverfront property, the Steam Plant is an iconic piece of Eugene's history and is ripe with potential.
