SANITARY SEWER SMOKE TESTING SCHEDULED FOR:

City of Eugene Public Works crews will be smoke testing the wastewater lines in your area on the date(s) shown above between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m. The testing will help us find defects in the lines that are allowing groundwater and stormwater to enter the wastewater collection system.

We will use a special non-toxic smoke that is safe for plants and animals and leaves no stains or residues. If your house is properly plumbed, the smoke will not enter your home, but will travel through the drains in your house and out the roof vents.

To minimize the chance of smoke entering your home, please run water into seldom-used fixtures and any floor drains in your utility rooms or basements.

If smoke does enter your home during testing, please contact the Public Works crew in your area or call our office at (541) 682-4800.

If you do see traces of smoke, this means your home is improperly plumbed and that sewer gases can also enter. Sewer gases are unpleasant and may be dangerous. We urge you to correct the problem as soon as possible.
