

Q1 Which area on the above map best describes your proximity to the future park?





Q3 Which of the following parks does your household currently utilize? (select all that apply)



Q4 What are your current reasons for travelling to a public park? (select all that apply)



Q5 Once Striker Field has been developed as a park, how would you primarily travel there?










