



As our greater downtown develops, it is important for Eugene's transportation network to have safe and comfortable connections regardless if travel is by car, on foot, bike, bus, or personal mobility device. The *Central Eugene In Motion* process will explore planned and potential changes with a focus on three key areas. The intent of this process is to work with the community to identify existing transportation issues, explore ideas, and identify preferred design concepts for projects listed in the 2017 Eugene Transportation System Plan.

The three *Central Eugene In Motion* focus areas are:

- Downtown on 8th Ave
- Amazon to Riverfront
- Midtown Willamette Street



Study Information

This study will examine the area bounded by 5th Avenue on the north, Lincoln Street on the west, High Street on the east, and 20th Avenue on the south. The goal of this study is to enhance the safety, connectivity and access of our street system in alignment with our community goals to promote people traveling by walking, biking and using transit; meet the needs of people driving and the movement and delivery of goods; and support the success of our downtown and midtown communities.

We will engage the community in conversations to...

Downtown on 8th

Explore options to improve walking and biking and beautify the streetscape as part of a project to convert 8th Ave. to two-way traffic.

Project Extent:

- 8th Ave. from Mill St. to Lincoln St.
- **Current funding:** Willamette to Mill*

Amazon to Riverfront

Identify a safe and connected network of bicycle facilities from the Amazon Path to Downtown Eugene and the Eugene Riverfront shared-use path system.

Project Extent:

- Pearl and High from 19th Ave. to 5th Ave.*

Midtown Willamette Street

Discuss traffic patterns and explore future scenarios near midtown Willamette Street to improve safety, connectivity and access for all transportation users.

Project Extent:

- Willamette and Oak* (18th - 20th Avenue)
- 18th, 19th*, and 20th* Avenues (between Willamette and High St.)
