ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING PROTECTIONS FOR INDIVIDUALS AND AMENDING SECTION 2.497 OF THE EUGENE CODE, 1971.

THE CITY OF EUGENE DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2.497 of the Eugene Code, 1971, is amended to provide as follows:

2.497 Information Not to Be Collected or Maintained.

- (1) No city law enforcement personnel may collect or maintain information about the political, religious or social views, associations or activities of any individual, group, association, organization, corporation, business or partnership unless such information directly relates to an investigation of criminal activities, and there are reasonable grounds to suspect the subject of the information is or may be involved in criminal conduct.
- (2) No non-law enforcement personnel working for the city may collect or maintain information about the political, religious or social views of any individual.
- (3) ***No city employee may collect or maintain individually identifiable immigration status information unless (a) such collection and maintenance is required to comply with state or federal law; (b) the individually identifiable immigration status information is voluntarily provided to the city by the individual; or (c) the information is provided to the city as part of a city application process for employment or a contract with the city, or a business permit or license from the city.***

Section 2. The City Recorder, at the request of, or with the consent of the City Attorney, is authorized to administratively correct any reference errors contained herein, or in other provisions of the Eugene Code, 1971, to the provisions added, amended or repealed herein.
