South Bank Shared Use Path Repair & Realignment

Project Overview:

- Work will occur along the South Bank shared use path between E 8th Ave and the Frohnmayer pedestrian bridge.
- Work will include rebuilding almost 3,000 linear feet of shared use path along the Willamette River. The current asphalt pavement will be replaced with a 12' wide concrete path with lighting and trail amenities and be moved back from the failing riverbank. Portions of the existing path will be converted into a gravel walking trail.
- Work will also install pedestrian lighting along the path.

Construction Schedule:

- This project is scheduled for construction in the late Fall of 2020 and early Summer of 2021.
- Prior to construction, utility companies (water, electricity, gas) may be on-site adjusting their facilities in order to avoid conflicts with the work and prevent damage to their facilities.

Traffic Impacts:

- Pedestrians and bicyclists should expect path closures and detours during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding are federal funds from ODOT and a Parks and Open Space bond.
