



Project Information Sheet

Garden Ave, Moss St, Villard St and Walnut St Pavement Preservation

Project Overview:

- Work will occur on:
 - Garden Ave from Moss St to Walnut St
 - Moss St from Franklin Blvd to Garden Ave
 - Walnut St from Franklin Blvd to Garden Ave
 - Villard St from Franklin Blvd to Garden Ave
- These streets have deteriorated pavement due to age and heavy traffic loading and need to be repaved.
- Work will also include reconstructing sidewalk access ramps throughout the project in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- This project is primarily intended to repair the street pavement, but the full scope of the work includes raised intersections, new sidewalk on Garden Avenue (between Moss St and Villard St), curb bump outs, speed humps, and stormwater planters on Moss and Villard St.

Construction Schedule:

- This project was awarded to Wildish Construction.
- Construction will start in July and continue through the Fall, construction will occur on one street segment at a time.
- Wildish is currently working on preparing Moss Street for paving (Phase 1) and concrete work along Garden Avenue and at the intersection with Villard Street.
- Phase 2 will include paving Villard Street and Walnut Street, including the construction of a raised intersection at the corner of Garden Avenue and Walnut Street. These streets will be closed during construction. Moss Street, Millrace Drive and Garden Avenue will remain open.

Traffic Impacts:

- Drivers should expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work at the intersections.
- Bicyclists should expect to be detoured through Walnut St (south of Franklin Blvd) to E 15th Ave to Agate St.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work day.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the 2017 Street Preservation Bond and City Fuel Tax.
