## 2020 Safe Routes to School Grant: Various Speed Monitoring and Crosswalk Enhancements

### Project Overview:

- Work will occur on several locations, at or near:
  - Cesar Chavez Elementary (4J)
  - Holt Elementary (4J)
  - Village School (4J)
  - Prairie Mountain School (Bethel)
  - Meadowview School (Bethel)
  - Malabon School (Bethel)
- These locations have been identified as hazardous to children walking or bicycling to and from school.
- Work will include constructing speed zone flashers, speed radars, rapid flashing beacons, crosswalks, and pedestrian islands in various locations.
- Work will also include reconstructing sidewalk access ramps throughout the project in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

### Construction Schedule:

- This project is substantially complete except for traffic signal and street light work.
- Traffic signal work including installation of RRFBs, School Zone flashers, and speed radar feedback signs, will occur in the beginning of October.
- All new crosswalks are now active and open.

### Traffic Impacts:

- Drivers should expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work at the intersections.
- Bicyclists should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic depending on available lane widths during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

### Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is a Safe Routes to School Grant.
