City of Eugene Spay and Neuter Clinic suspending services

The City of Eugene Spay and Neuter Clinic, located at 3970 W 1st Ave., is suspending services from Saturday, March 14, through Tuesday, March 31, in order to reduce public impact of COVID-19. The City will continually assess the situation and change hours accordingly. With community members' and employees' safety as our number one priority, and due to the large number of walk-in customers visiting the clinic daily, Spay and Neuter Clinic closure is intended to reduce the likelihood of infections in the community.

Animal surgeries previously scheduled for this time period will be rescheduled to later dates in April and May. Clinic staff will contact animal owners by phone to find new dates. Clinic employees will continue reporting to work and will practice suggested social distancing and disinfection protocols. Customers who rely on the clinic as their source of discounted flea and tick medications are advised to seek other sources, such as pet supply retailers.
