2020 STM West 36th to Monroe CDS Storm Improvements Project

Project Overview:

- New storm drain pipe and structures will be constructed on 36th Avenue near Monroe Street and on Monroe Street from 38th Avenue to the Cul-De-Sac where it will tie into the existing storm system
- This project is primarily intended to improve drainage and reduce flooding with construction of new storm systems but additional repairs to curbs, driveways, sidewalks and pavement should be expected.

Construction Schedule:

- This project is tentatively scheduled for construction to begin October 2020 and be completed early November 2020.
- Prior to the start of construction, the City's arborists may be on-site trimming trees to prevent overhead limbs from being damaged by construction equipment.
- Also prior to construction, utility companies (water, electricity, gas) may be on-site adjusting their facilities in order to avoid conflicts with the work and prevent damage to their facilities.

Traffic Impacts:

- Drivers should expect lane and road closures and lane shifts during construction.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours.
- Bicyclists should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic depending on available lane widths during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.
- Availability of on-street parking may be reduced or closed during construction.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the Storm Rehabilitation Fund.
