



# Project Information Sheet

## 2020 Roosevelt Multi-Use Path from Maple St to Hwy 99

### Project Overview:

- This project will repurpose the existing sidewalk and bike lane on the north side of Roosevelt Boulevard into a new multi-use path, connecting the existing paths at Maple Street and Highway 99.
- Work will also include reconstructing sidewalk access ramps in order to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

### Construction Schedule:

- Construction is complete and the path is open to pedestrians and bicycles

### Traffic Impacts:

- Drivers should expect lane closures and lane shifts during construction.
- Pedestrians should expect sidewalk detours during the sidewalk ramp work
- Bicyclists should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic depending on available lane widths during construction.
- With any construction, drivers should expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading to congestion and delays during the work.

### Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the State Funded Local Project Program.
