Submit your resume, which should include work and volunteer experience, relevant education and training, contact information, and references.

Answer the following questions on a separate document, and submit it with your resume.

1. Adaptive Recreation's mission is to provide diverse recreation programs and services that enhance the quality of life for people with disabilities. Given that, please write a paragraph to answer each of these questions:
 - a. What is your own philosophy related to community therapeutic recreation?
 - b. What do you want to gain from your internship experience?
 - c. Why do you want to work with us at Adaptive Recreation in Eugene, specifically?
2. If you could remove one barrier for people with disabilities to make it easier to access community recreation, what barrier would you eliminate? Please include why and how you would help to mitigate this barrier.
3. What do you see yourself doing in 3 years?

In order to be considered for the next season, internship applications are by due by following dates:

February 15th for summer session (June – Sept)

May 15th for fall session (Sept – Dec)

October 15th for winter session (Jan – April)

After the due date listed above, your materials will then be reviewed by the Adaptive Recreation staff. The top candidates will then be selected for a Skype or phone interview. Please prepare any questions you might have before the interview.

Following the interview, you will be notified within three weeks. We will communicate with you whether or not you are selected as an intern for our site.
