


URBAN RESERVES 30-Year Option



Largest Urban Reserve option; provides the most flexibility in the future for urban growth boundary expansion.

This option reserves enough land to meet the projected needs of 30 years of growth beyond 2032, based on Eugene's expected population in 2062.

A 30-year Urban Reserve is the maximum size allowed by law.
