

How to take your bike on the bus



1. Make Eye Contact

Before stepping in front of the bus, make eye contact with the bus driver to indicate you are loading a bike.

2. Release

Squeeze the handle to release the rack from its upright position.

3. Load

Lift your bike onto the bike rack, fitting the wheels into the wheel slots. The slots are labeled for front and rear wheels.

4. Secure

Raise the support arm up and over the front tire. For BMX-style bikes, place the support arm over the bike's frame. Racks are specially constructed to safely transport most types of bicycles.

5. Unload

When you arrive at your stop, always exit through the front door. Before you exit the bus, let the bus driver know that you are going to unload your bike.

6. Raise Rack

If there are no more bikes left on the rack after removing your bike, put the rack back in the upright position.

On the EmX

EmX buses have a bike rack on the inside with room to hold three bikes.

Here's how to take your bike on the EmX:

1. Enter through the rear door of the EmX vehicle.
2. Place your bike in the bike rack.
3. Secure your bike using the velcro straps.
4. Stand by your bike.
5. When you arrive at your stop, exit through the back door.

On rural routes

On rural routes, two bikes may be loaded inside the bus in the wheelchair area if the front rack is full. However, seniors and customers with disabilities are given priority for this space. You may be asked to remove your bike prior to arriving at your destination in order to accommodate customers.



Don't forget!

Loading and unloading your bike is your responsibility; the bus driver cannot assist you.

LTD drivers are committed to providing quality service. Loading and unloading your bike quickly will help them keep that commitment.

Remove any attachments from your bike that may interfere with the safe operation of the bus. Bike racks can accommodate standard bicycles. Most buses are equipped with bike racks with room for three bicycles.

Use designated bike racks for locking your bike at bus stops. Do not lock your bike to LTD bus stop poles.
