Polk Street Paving

Project Description:

- Polk Street shows signs of deterioration, due to pavement age and traffic loading, and is scheduled for repaving. The repaving project will also reconstruct sidewalk access ramps along Polk Street throughout the project, in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Project Scope:

- The following streets will be repaved and the sidewalk access ramps will be reconstructed:
 - Polk Street (from 18th Avenue to 28th Avenue)

Construction Schedule:

- Project construction is planned to start in the summer 2023.

Travel Impacts:

- People driving should expect road closures and lane shifts during construction, use alternate routes when possible.
- People biking should expect to merge with motor vehicle traffic, depending on available lane widths during construction, use alternate routes when possible.
- People walking should expect detours and some temporary closed crossings
- On street parking will be restricted to accommodate construction activities.
- Expect equipment and workers in the roadway leading, with possible congestions and delays.

Project Funding:

- The major source of funding is the 2017 Street Preservation Bond.
- The secondary source of funding is the gasoline tax.
