South Willamette Street Enhancement (Eugene)

Project Overview:

- This project involved reconstruction of South Willamette Street and its sidewalks, driveway aprons, street lights, pedestrian signals, and storm drainage system from 24th Avenue to 29th Avenue. The project also included resurfacing of the pavement from 23rd Avenue to 24th Avenue and installation of rain gardens (curbed stormwater treatment planters) to some side streets near where they intersect with Willamette Street.
- This project is mostly complete with the exception of several repairs.

Repair Schedule:

- 3 light poles have been knocked down on South Willamette Street. The City has 2 poles in stock that will be replaced in approximately March, 2023. Additional materials to replace the third pole are being ordered and that work will be done as soon as possible. City electricians have made sure that all wiring is secured inside the adjacent junction boxes. Any wires visible are ground wires and pose no public safety risk.
- 8 trees were damaged on South Willamette Street. The City has contracted with Four Seasons to replace these trees as well as to install tree guards for all of the new trees that were planted as part of the project. This work is expected to be done in approximately March, 2023.
