#### BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AND EUGENE CITY COUNCIL

Notice is hereby given that the Board of County Commissioners will conduct a joint Public Hearing with the Eugene City Council on Tuesday, February 28, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. The public hearing will be held remotely using virtual meeting technology. The public hearing is on the following proposal:

(City of Eugene) AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING URBAN RESERVES FOR THE CITY OF EUGENE; AMENDING THE EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD METROPOLITAN GENERAL PLAN; AMENDING THE ENVISION EUGENE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AND AMENDING THE PUBLIC FACILITIES AND SERVICES PLAN

(Lane County) ORDINANCE NO. PA1388/ IN THE MATTER OF ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING URBAN RESERVES FOR THE CITY OF EUGENE; AMENDING THE EUGENE-SPRINGFIELD METROPOLITAN AREA GENERAL PLAN; AMENDING THE LANE COUNTY RURAL COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AMENDING THE ENVISION EUGENE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AMENDING THE PUBLIC FACILITIES AND SERVICES PLAN.
