Fixing Eugene's Streets

West 18th Avenue Pavement Preservation Project

Paving of West 18th Avenue from Washington Street to 510' east of Chambers Street

Project Location

West 18th Avenue from Washington Street to 510' east of Chambers Street.

Project Overview

- The street is showing significant deterioration, thus the existing pavement will be completely removed and the subgrade soils will be treated with lime and cement prior to repaving the street.
- Sidewalk access ramps will be reconstructed at most locations.

Construction Schedule

- Knife River Corporation was awarded the construction contract.
- The work is scheduled to be complete in late September.

Traffic Impacts

- Watch for construction signs and equipment.
- The street reconstruction is divided into four phases. The full street width will be closed during the reconstruction of each phase.
- The first phase of full street closure is anticipated to begin in late July.
- During street closure, the following streets should be used as detours: 11th Avenue, 13th Avenue, 24th Avenue and 28th Avenue.



Project Funding

Major Funding Sources include the 2008 Street Bond and Local Gas Taxes.
